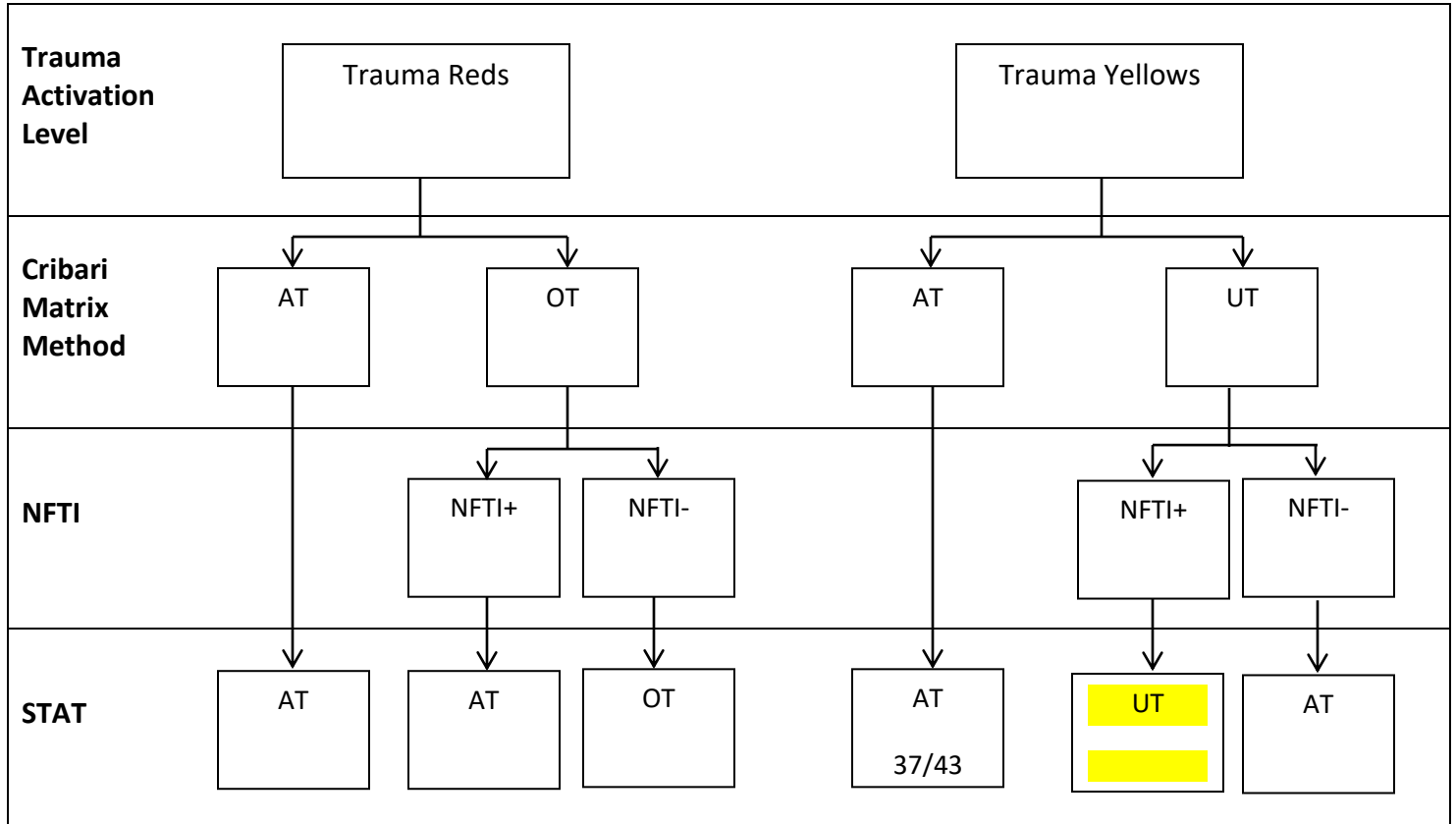


# NFTI INDEX

## Trauma Reds and Trauma Yellows: Upgrades



AT=Appropriate Triage

OT=Overtriage

UT=Undertriage

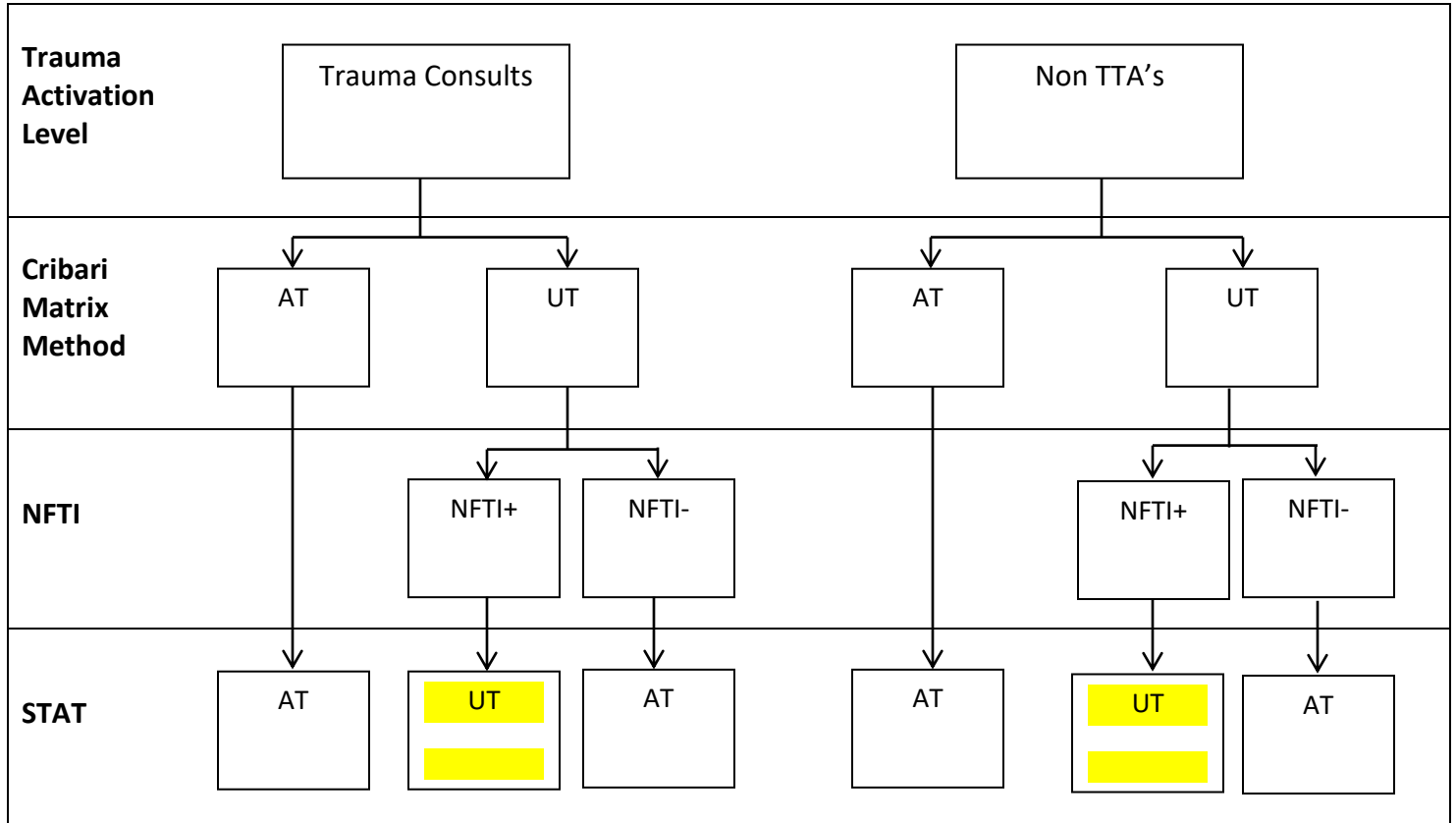
## NFTI CRITERIA

- Received PRB's within 4 hours of arrival
- Discharge from ED to OR within 90 minutes
- Discharge from ED to Interventional Radiology
- Discharge from ED to ICU and remain there for > or = 3 calendar days
- Receiving mechanical ventilation within 3 days of arrival
- Mortality within 60 hours of arrival

**If patients meet any of the NFTI criteria they are classified as NFTI+ and considered to have suffered major trauma warranting a full TTA.**
